CIRCULAR

It is our pleasure to welcome you all to Bengaluru, Karnataka to **37th Sub-Junior & 47th Junior and 74th Senior National Aquatic Championship 2021.**

The above championships will be conducted in Basavanagudi Aquatic Centre, Corporation swimming pool, Basavanagudi, Bengaluru.

It's a great honour for us to host the Championship again we will do our best and we request co-operation to all office bearers of Swimming Federation of India and all affiliated units for the successful conduct of the championship.

Every Person who wants to enter the Pool premises should have a Negative test report of RTPCR from a valid Lab not later than 72 hours.

Only One Parent will be allowed with one swimmer inside the pool area.

Parent ID card to be collected after submitting the RTPCR test report.

SFI ID is compulsory for all Participants. All Swimmers should carry a hard copy of the ID card.

SFI will have a special counter for generating ID cards for the swimmers could not generate it due to various reasons.

1.0 RECEPTION

Reception will be made available at the Pool venues for all the enquiries.

2.0 TRANSPORTATION

As we mentioned in the SFI Circular Due to Covid -19 pandemic we are not providing transportation during the above championships. Kindly make a note of the same.

3.0 ACCOMMODATION

There are many hotels which are available close to the pools and parents are requested to make their own arrangements directly. However few hotels addresses are given for reference, which is attached to this document.

4.0 BOARDING ARRANGEMENTS

Food will be made available to all competitors and team officials at subsidized rates of Rs.750/- (for Sub Junior & Junior) & Rs.600/- (for Senior) will be charged per head for all days a total package of Breakfast, Lunch and dinner on all days of the competitions.

Food and Breakfast will be supplied only against coupons which shall be bought by the participants on the day of arrival. The coupons will be available at the venue of

Championships. Team managers may contact our food committee members who will be available at the venues.

5.0 MEDICAL SERVICE

A first aid station will be established at each venue, staffed by the doctors to provide emergency medical assistance during the competitions. If more sophisticated medical treatment is required or in case of emergency, our volunteers will help the team managers in directing them to the specified medical institutions under the instruction of medical officers.

In case of emergency, ambulance will be called at the discretion of the physician.

6.0 WEATHER

Weather in Bangalore in the month of October will be mildly warm and cool at nights but rains are expected during this month.

Teams are advised to come with rain jackets, umbrellas and light & warm clothes.

8.0 GUIDELINES TO MANAGERS SUB JUNIOR, JUNIOR & SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS (SWIMMING, DIVING & WATERPOLO)

The following guidelines are to be observed by all team managers and competitors during the championships to be held at Basavanagudi Aquatic Centre. Basavanagudi, Bengaluru.

A) Entries:

Any corrections, errors and withdrawals should be reported to SFI Management Committee during the team managers meeting.

B) Meeting of Team Managers

Team Managers meeting for all disciplines will be held at Basavanagudi Aquatic Centre. Basavanagudi, Bengaluru on 18th October at 4.00 pm.

All Team Managers are requested to be present well in time for the meeting at Basavanagudi Aquatic Centre. Basavanagudi, Bengaluru **Meeting of Technical Officials**

All Technical Officials authorised by Swimming Federation of India who officiate in these Championships are requested to attend the meeting on 18th October 2021 at 5.00 pm. The above meetings will be held at Basavanagudi Aquatic Centre. Basavanagudi, Bengaluru immediately after Manager meeting.

C) Seating Arrangements:

There are seats reserved for the competitors and officials on the left side of the spectators' stand. Swimmers scheduled to participate in a particular event of the day are requested to be at the Competitors enclosure for better management.

D) Warm Ups :

Warm ups will be allowed at the main competition pool and also at the adjoining short course swimming pool before the commencement of the swimming sessions (Heat/Finals).

E) Timings of Swimming finals

Finals of swimming events for senior Nationals will be held from 4.00 p.m onwards. All managers are requested to note the timings of the finals.

F) Registration & Presentation of Swimmers :

For all sessions, swimmers in the first three Heats/Finals of the scheduled event must report to the clerk of the course before the last call. Competitors will be led by marshals and shall proceed in a single line from the registration enclosure to the starting area, with the swimmers in lane – 1 leading the group, followed by swimmers in lane – 2,3,4,5,6,7 & 8 in that order.

As the name of each competitor is called, before the race begins, the swimmers are required to stand next to their starting block and acknowledge the spectators and to remain there until the introduction has been completed.

G) Victory Ceremonies :

Presentation of medals to the winners will be held after the completion of two events in the Finals Session of Swimming.

During the victory ceremony the medal winners will be escorted from pool deck to the Victory Podium. After the presentation, swimmers are requested to be available for media interviews (if required).

It is the responsibility of the team managers to ensure that their swimmers are available for the victory ceremony in time.
